Doug's doctors at the hospital connected the family with Karuna for palliative care support. As our clinical team spent more time with Mary and Doug, they became aware of Mary's worries for the future and decided to refer her for social work support.

Our social worker Janie was able to help alleviate some of Mary's worries and prepare her for a future without Doug. After Doug passed peacefully in their family home, Mary and Janie remained in contact and continue to exchange letters and phone calls.

Getting started

Before you start organising your fundraising event, check out this simple step by step guide to help you make your event a success.

If you get stuck at any point in the process, please send us an email or give us a call, we are always happy to help.

STEP 1 - Choose a fundraiser

If you need some inspiration, read our fundraising ideas on page 6-7! Choose something that you're passionate about, or something that will be fun for you to organise and participate in.

STEP 5 - Spread the word

The best way to advertise your fundraiser is to **talk about it**. Tell everyone you know about your fundraiser – by word of mouth, direct messaging or posts on social media. If you need any help with advertising, you can visit **this link** to download promotional posters, social media tiles and more.

STEP 2 - Set some goals

Now that you've chosen your fundraiser, don't forget the details! You'll need to think about when you'd like to host your fundraiser, how you're going to advertise and who you're advertising to.

STEP 6 – The big day has arrived!

Don't forget to say a personal thank you to everyone who has donated to your fundraiser! Make sure you post on social media during the event to encourage others to make donations – and tag us on social media (@karunahospice) so we can share your photos and posts too!

STEP 3 – What we need from you

STEP 7 – How to make your donations

You've made it to the end of your fundraiser and we can't wait to hear how you went! Please remember that any funds raised will need to be banked within two weeks after the end of your fundraiser. You can reach us at **community@karuna.org.au** for banking details and more information.

STEP 4 - Make it official

Before you start your fundraiser, you'll need to fill out our **Fundraising Application Form**. We want to know a little more about you and your planned fundraiser! You'll also need a **Letter of Authority**, which we will provide you with after we've reviewed your fundraising application.

STEP 8 – Congratulations!

Your fundraiser is complete! Thank you for supporting Karuna. We love hearing from our amazing fundraisers and seeing the work you do in our communities. We hope you feel proud of your achievements and the knowledge that you are making a difference to terminally ill patients and their families.

Double your impact

Get the ball rolling

Get social

Community fundraising guidelines



Whilst this is not the most exciting page in this guide, it is an important one. Karuna is an Australian Charities and Not-for-profit Commission (ACNC) registered charity, and we must ensure our fundraisers are aware of their obligations.

Fundraising legislation

All fundraising activities and events must meet the requirements of relevant laws and regulations in your State or Territory and you will need to obtain any necessary permits or licenses required.

Financial records and expenses

It is important you comply with the Charitable Fundraising Act and regulations for your state which might include the provision of accurate financial records, including a budget to Karuna.

Funds must be deposited within 30 days of the end date of your event or activity. You will receive emails from our Fundraising Team if we haven't heard from you within a week of your event or activity finishing. We will provide you banking details along with your personalised Banking Reference Number to use when banking your funds.

Promotion

We will give you an Authority to Fundraise Letter confirming you have been approved as a fundraiser for Karuna. You are then permitted to use the Karuna logo to publicise your event. If you produce marketing materials using the Karuna name and logo, please send us a copy prior for approval.

When using the Karuna name in promotion of your event or fundraiser it is important to note that the activity is not being managed by Karuna but instead is an activity held 'in support of Karuna'. Suggested phrasing could be: 'Trivia night in support of Karuna' or 'Trivia night with all proceeds going to Karuna'.

Karuna reserve the right to terminate our support for the fundraising activity or event at any time if it appears that there is a likelihood of the organiser failing to meet any of the above responsibilities.
